### **Summary**

1. Privilege offers no protection from wrath. People in America today are more privileged than any other people in history. Yet none of this privilege will shield us from the flood of God's wrath against our sin.
2. Hearing God's word is never enough. You will not benefit from God's word unless you DO it.
3. Be careful, the more you know, the more you will be held accountable for! (Cf. Luke 12:48; 11:32; Hebrews 2:3)

### **Questions for discussion or personal reflection**

1. Issues of privilege aside, what is the fate for those who sin according to verse 12? How is it different or the same depending on the person's privilege or lack thereof?
2. Is anyone given a pass when it comes to God's judgment? Why or why not?
3. List the spiritual things that you have been blessed with by God. How can you respond correctly to all that "privilege"?
4. When it comes to hearing versus hearing and doing God's Word, why is the doing so hard? What can you do to help yourself put more of God's word into practice in your life?
5. When you think about the concepts of right and wrong, how could you demonstrate to someone that they believe in right and wrong even if they don't admit to it? Where does that concept come from?
6. What are you doing to ensure that you hear, "Well done, good and faithful servant" from the Lord at the judgment?
