### Questions for discussion

1. How can the truth that Jesus really does have compassion for people who are suffering be an encouragement to you? (John 11:33; 35; Hebrews 4:15-16) Can you think of any references from the psalms where the psalmist cries out to God in his despair (example Psalm 77).
2. Consider the omnipotence (all powerful) of Christ when He cried with a loud voice, **Lazarus, come out!** Consider other examples from the Bible which declare the power of Jesus Christ (example John 1:3). How can this encourage you in a world of chaos and despair?
3. How is it that some people will refuse to believe even though the evidence is before their eyes? Relate Luke 16:19-31 and the text of John 11 in your answer. How can this keep you from getting discouraged when you witness?
