### **Questions for Discussion**

1. Why do people seem to follow the crowd? How often is the crowd correct?
2. Explain the difference between the "crowd" and the "committed" who followed Jesus. (Or the difference between a "fan" of Jesus and a "follower")
3. Jesus told the crowd not to work for food that spoils. What things do we spend our time and efforts on that only last a short time? What things last forever?
4. Jesus was speaking figuratively, as he did with Nicodemus and the woman at the well. Why do people misunderstand Jesus' statements here?
5. Though we celebrate communion and remember Jesus' body and blood, how do we know that this is NOT what Jesus was talking about here in John 6?
6. How does the repetition in the passage help us understand Jesus' meaning?
