5. Do we really believe what the Bible teaches about hell? If so, are we living like we believe it, or are we practically ignoring it? How do we need to change because of this truth?
6. How might Romans 9:16-23 affect our understanding of hell and what God *can* do? If God declares something to be true, why do we hesitate to believe/declare it?
