

## **The Interpreter's Bible (published 1955)**

Where Praise Is to Be Offered. – The first question is answered at once: Praise God in his sanctuary. The word sanctuary can be understood in various senses. There are expositors who make it mean the temple or some other prepared place of worship. This conforms to long and universal usage. If we do not join with others at stated times in the sanctuaries men have built and dedicated, the chances are that we shall soon lose the habit of worship. There are some indeed who assert that they can remain devout in mind and act though they neglect the public offices of prayer and praise. The common experience, however, is that as church attendance declines personal religion declines also. Even if the individual could succeed in maintaining his private devotions, he would lose the corporate realization that comes from common worship. That is one reason why the broadcast service can never give complete satisfaction. It may prove to be a channel of grace to many, in hospitals and sickrooms; but it cannot take the place of that assembling together which has always been to Christians the very fellowship of the body of the risen Lord.”
