July 5, 2020

The Bible was written in the context of history.

1. The Bible gives us direction for living  
*(2 Timothy 3:16-17)*
2. The Bible tells us about the good from history  
*(Genesis 1:31)*
3. The Bible tells us about the bad from history

- 1). Satan is the author of sin (Ezekiel 28:15).
- 2). Man fell into sin (Genesis 3).
- 3). Man has turned away from God in willful rebellion (Romans 1:18-25).
- 4). The problem of sin is universal (Romans 3:23).
- 5). Even the heroes of the faith have sinned

Moses - Numbers 20:12-13; Deuteronomy 34:4

David - 2 Samuel 11-13; Psalm 51 & 32

Isaiah - Isaiah 6:5

Peter - Luke 22:54-62

4. Failures of the past are recorded for a warning for us today (*1 Corinthians 10:1-13*)

5. We need to love others for the cause of Christ (*Matthew 5:43-48*)

2). Why do you think it is important to share personal stories of God's faithfulness with our children and grandchildren? What are some stories that you could share at this time in your life?
